activities such as canoeing, horseback safari, bicycling, abseiling and nature walks.

Day 4-5: Drive to **Ngorongoro Crater**, considered an 8th wonder of the world, and experience fabulous panoramic views from the crater rim. Descend to the crater floor to watch rhinos, cheetahs, hippos and other diverse animals. Overnight at the **Ngorongoro Sopa Lodge**.

Day 6-7: Drive to **Serengeti** and experience the diverse flora and fauna, unexposed gold and mineral mines, superb sunsets on smooth landscapes, the number one wonder on the list – the great wildebeest migration. Overnight at the **Serengeti Sopa Lodge**.
